



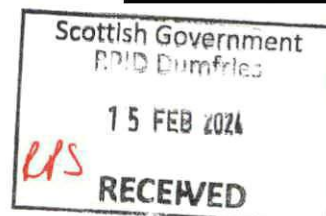

As you can see from the freshly cut fields in the maps the ground which we intend to remove underlying stone / material is already intensively farmed, already being cut 3 or 4 times per year.

The shallow excavations would involve material being rounded off in the areas circled on the maps. The ground would then be reseeded.

Within field 29 = NX/61506/47301 there is an area coloured red, this area would not be touched.

No existing wildlife habitat will be altered as the ground is silage fields with underlying hazards for machinery.

I don't know what benefit a scoping meeting would be so I ticked both boxes.

Excavations would be at least 25m from classified roads.
