



As you can see from the freshly cut fields in the maps the ground which we intend to remove underlying stone material is already intensively farmed, already being cut 3 or 4 twines per year.

The shallow excavations would enable material being rounded off in the areas circled on the maps. The ground would then be researched then be researed.
