	During the two site visits in 2024 it was clear that the derelict nature of this previously farmed land had led to a thick matt of dead agricultural grasses interspersed with dockans. ND/48136/93554 still had evidence of potato drills and ND/48309/93584 and pt ND/48265/93694 had been cut for silage in the past 15 years. This area was poor in biodiversity with very little evidence of indicator species due to its abandonment.
